The object is to have students in grades 3-5 read at least 3 of the Oklahoma nominated books and then they vote on their favorite in April. There is always a picture book on the list, so this is definitely something that is attainable in the time frame.

We are still going to have a contest this year, but will have different guidelines than in the years past to accommodate our growth in students and allow more time for being able to get the books for those that want to read them all. *Reading in the Park* is Wednesday, September 28th where the books are presented by the teachers and organized by the 8th grade leadership class. The contest will begin after that with books being available to purchase or check out. The books will be sold from Sept. 28-Oct. 14 in the elementary library. The price sheet will be included on the back of this note with titles.

Here are the dates for contest and what we need from the parents is a signed note saying their child read the allotted number of books by the dates shown below.

Sept. 28 through Jan. 6th – Read the required 3

Each student that reads at least 3 books on the list has the right to vote and receives a treat.

Sept. 28 through Mar. 30 – Read 14 of the 16 books on list.

Each student that reads the 14 will get to attend a special lunch and receive a prize.
